

# Uniform Policy for all Elementary, K-8, and Middle Buildings

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Can my student wear a standard, non-collared t-shirt, even if it is the right color?**

A: Students are required to wear collared shirts. This may include polo shirts and Oxford (button-up) shirts.

**Q: What colors should my student wear?**

A: Students are required to wear shirts that are black, red, navy blue, light blue, white, or orange and either tan, navy or black khaki pants. Each building will communicate their preferred colors to parents; however, no colors will be strictly prohibited.

**Q: Can my student wear a sweatshirt over their shirt?**

A: Students may not wear hoodies or crewneck sweatshirts over their uniform shirt. Students may wear sweaters, track jackets or fleece jackets over their uniform shirt.

**Q: What are my student's options when it gets cold?**

A: Students may wear long-sleeve polos or Oxford shirts. They may also wear long-sleeved shirts under their uniform shirt.

**Q: Can my student wear black or navy jeans?**

A: Student may not wear denim – even if the denim is black, navy or tan.

**Q: Can my student wear colorful tights or socks with a skirt?**

A: Yes. Students may wear any color tights, nylons, leggings, or socks under a skirt, skort, shorts, or pants. This is subject to be limited by the building administrator.

**Q: Can my student wear any kind of shoe?**

A: Students may wear the shoe of their choice as long as it complies with the District policy.

**Q: Are there any restrictions regarding accessories?**

A: Students may wear jewelry, belts, buttons, etc. as long as they comply with the District policy and are not a distraction or offensive. This is subject to be limited by the building administrator.

**Q: Is my student's shirt required to have the school's logo?**

A: The District is not requiring that uniform shirts have the school logo embroidered or pressed on them. Students may wear shirts that contain the school logo. This is subject to be limited by the building administrator.

**Q: What happens if my student does not wear a uniform?**

A: If your student is found to be in non-compliance with the District's and/or school's uniform policy, consequences ranging from a note home to suspension will follow.
